## Scholarship Disclosure

NWAYP reserves the right to promote the recipients of its scholarships and may request a photo to be placed on its Web site.

Each student who is awarded a NWAYP Scholarship must provide to NWAYP his or her contact information, such as a mailing address, e-mail address, phone number where the recipient can be reached, and the appropriate contact information of the student's college (i.e., Registrar's Office, Treasurer's Office, etc.) to set up payment in the second semester. Each Scholarship recipient will provide, at NWAYP's request, his or her first semester college grades.

The Scholarship funds will be directly applied to each recipient's academic bill at the beginning of the second semester in which the student is enrolled in the college or university. If the student's first semester grade point average is below 2.0 on a 4.0 scale or if the student does not enroll in a two-year or four-year public or private college in Washington County or Benton County, Arkansas for the student's second semester of college, the NWAYP Board may withhold payment of funds to the student's academic bill.

Items on a student's academic bill for which NWAYP funds may be paid do not include anything other than tuition, fees or classroom textbooks. Non-textbook related items such as a university cafeteria plan or clothing items will not be paid for with NWAYP Scholarship funds. NWAYP will maintain a file with receipts of monies paid toward each student's academic bill for each scholarship year.
